Principal's Report

Staggered Start to Term 4

The end of remote learning is in sight and we have received a **roadmap from the State Government**, which will see all students return to onsite learning in Week 4 on Tuesday October 26. In the meantime our Junior classroom returns fulltime from day 1 of Term 4, whilst our Grade 3-6 students participate in a staggered transition back to face to face learning.
