Prep Health Assessments: All parents of prep grade children will be requested to complete a Health Questionnaire and return the form to the school before April 24th 2017.

Referrals (All Grades): Parents and/or teachers may refer children from any grade for assessments of vision, hearing, basic speech, physical abilities, medical conditions, behavioural and parenting issues. Please collect a referral form from the school office. Completed forms are to be handed into the school office prior to April 24th 2017. Should parents wish to have an interview with the School Nurse, please indicate your request on the form.
