School Attendance Regular school attendance is very important.

- 1. Obviously, a regular attendance is beneficial in a student's learning.
- 2. Teachers will often need to spend time with a student directly who has missed a crucial teaching point which takes time away from the rest of the class.
- 3. A student will feel much more a part of a school if their attendance is regular.
- 4. It is often disappointing for other students when one of their friends are not at school regularly.
- 5. It is expected that students attend school every day, except in the case of illness, medical reasons or genuine pressing family needs.
- 6. From the start of term 3 we are required to follow up on students not at school that day. If your child is away please ring the school to tell us and the reason why. If we are not informed we are required to call you.

The train leaves Swan Hill Railway Station at 6.58 am on the Monday morning. There is no doubt that the train will not wait for late arrivals. Please be there by 6.50 am at the latest.

- The train arrives back in Swan Hill on the Wednesday evening at 11.01 pm.
- Main Children will need to bring a sleeping bag, pillow slip and towels as well as the required toiletries.
- A small back pack and a drink bottle are required.
- Clothing: Enough for three days keeping in mind Melbourne's unpredictable weather. Don't forget a coat or jacket and make sure your shoes can walk a few miles. Kilometers.
- Children will need to bring a cut throw away lunch and snacks for the train trip on the Monday.
- Please no mobile phones. If you need to contact your child you can ring the camp or our mobiles listed above.
- Please no Gameboys or Walkmans or the likes. Part of the camp's aims are to encourage social interaction and they can go missing which causes problems. Cameras are OK.
- If any child displays serious poor behavior the parent is responsible to collect their child upon request by the supervising teachers.
- No need for spending money.
- A van will pick up our luggage at the station on arrival in Melbourne and will drop it off for our return home.

I have put out this information sheet relatively early so you can ensure your child has everything they need.

Two suggestions, and only suggestions.

- That all your child's clothing, bedding, etc fits into 1 piece of luggage. We do have to walk with it quite a distance at Southern Cross Station.
- The smaller the backpack the better. All it will need to have in it is a drink bottle and maybe a jacket or jumper....and lunch and snacks for the train trip to camp.
