IT'S NOT OK TO BE AWAY

The average absence per student at our school is around 9 days per year. Our absenteeism figures are traditionally below the state average.

Recent figures from Education suggest that only 40 per cent of students absent from schools on any given day are away for genuine reasons. These statistics are somewhat swayed by secondary school data; however absenteeism is still a concern within the primary sector.

A worthwhile slogan is, "Be on time, be at school; that's the rule." It is important for parents to understand that every day a student is away without reason, the absence is costing that child a learning experience.

ABSENCE NOTES

School attendance rolls are legal documents, and under Australian law schools must account for student absences. If your child is absent for whatever reason, the school requires a verbal message or written note indicating the date and reason for the absence.
