CLASSROOM REQUISITE CHARGES

Classroom requisites are now due; School Council set the price at \$110 dollars for the first child and \$90 for the second child. These charges are for the materials that your child/children receives at school including, pencils, pens, erasers, books, paper, art materials etc. Some schools ask parents to supply these at the beginning of the year, Beverford PS find it is cheaper if we buy in bulk and distribute to students. PAYMENT PLANS

Please call and see me about making regular deposits weekly, fortnightly or monthly to cover these costs. If you have a credit at the end of the year you can request to have it paid back to you, or you can roll it over to the following year.
