NAPLAN Testing Results for grade 3 and 5 Students

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy results have been returned to school. Your child's results are enclosed. The assessments were held in term 2 in the areas of English (Reading, Writing, Spelling and Grammar and Punctuation) and Mathematics.

Information gained from the NAPLAN can be a useful part in determining a student's overall progress and achievement. However in viewing the information contained in your child's report the following points should be kept in mind:

- 1. Children begin school at different levels of readiness and progress through their schooling at different rates so it is difficult to have a 'level playing field' for these external assessments. A number of variables can influence the result.
- 2. The reports should be read with the understanding that the assessments were completed in May and are a snapshot on a particular day of your child's performance in each area. Teachers use a wide variety of assessment techniques, over a wide time frame when writing reports for your child.
