- Please no Gameboys or Walkmans or the likes. Part of the camp's aims are to encourage social interaction and they can go missing which causes problems.
- If any child displays serious poor behavior the parent is responsible to collect their child upon request by the supervising teachers.

- Students in Grades 4, 5 & 6 will have the option of going horse riding. To do this boots or fully enclosed shoes must be worn and the attached indemnity form completed. Other grades will go on the carriage ride. If a child decides not to go horse riding on the day that is fine.
