Every child deserves a good childhood.

Foster Care is a way of providing a family life for a vulnerable child in your own home.

Foster Care

Our Foster Care programs are also known as "Out of Home Care" and "Home Based Care".

The programs are a home based placement service which provide care to children and young people who cannot five with their families for a variety of reasons. The programs could include options of Therapeutic Care (VIC) and Kinship placements (NSW).

Foster Care can provide respite, short, medium and long-term care for children and young people on statutory orders and voluntary under Victorian and New South Wales laws. Referrals are primarily made by Child Protection services in Victoria and New South Wales.

Mallee Family Care Foster Carers are valued members of the team. Foster Carers undergo compulsory screening and training before being approved to have placements berote being approved to have placement of children and young people into their homes. Placements are individually supported by Maliee Family Care staff, with ongoing training and various other placement supports, including access to an after hours oncall system.
