NEWS FROM THE OFFICE

Charges have now been put on for the 2015 Class Requisites (the materials that the school purchases on behalf of you for your child). School council have set the fees at \$120 per student or

\$210.00 per family. Payment can be made via cheque, cash or.... (my favourite) <u>direct deposited</u> into the schools account. Some families make regular payments of \$20 per fortnight, which I take off any outstanding charges. It is much easier to budget \$10 or \$20 a week than to find \$200 for that camp that you know is coming up at some stage this year. If your account is in credit at the end of the year this can be paid back to you, or you can roll it over for the following year. You can see your bank and have an automatic payment set up to go out of your account weekly or fortnightly. Statements can be provided at any stage, just give me a call or send a note with your child if you require one.
